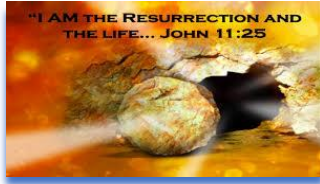

➤ **I AM THE RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE**

Martha thought of an event; Jesus revealed that he, a p\_\_\_\_\_, is the resurrection and the life.

Martha spoke of resurrection as if it were only a future gift of God to be dispensed by Christ at the end of time. But Christ's assertion required that she focus not on resurrection but on h\_\_\_\_\_.

Jesus is not the d\_\_\_\_\_ of resurrection; he is resurrection!

➤ **HE WHO BELIEVES IN ME, THOUGH HE MAY DIE, HE SHALL LIVE. AND WHOEVER LIVES AND BELIEVES IN ME SHALL NEVER DIE.**

Eternal life cannot be extinguished by p\_\_\_\_\_l death.

For those who are born only once will die twice, once physically and once again at the "second death" or final separation from God. But those who are born twice will only die once (physically), but will live with God forever.

➤ **DO YOU BELIEVE THIS?"**

Jesus is not asking if she believes that he is about to raise her brother from the dead, but if her faith can go beyond quiet confidence that her brother will be resurrected at the last day to personal trust in Jesus as the resurrection and the life, the only person who can grant eternal life and promise the t\_\_\_\_\_ of resurrection.

➤ **"YES, LORD, I BELIEVE THAT YOU ARE THE CHRIST, THE SON OF GOD, WHO IS TO COME INTO THE WORLD."**
