How to Be Faithful Until God's Plan is Fulfilled!

I. Faith F_____ (1-3)

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. 2 For by it the elders obtained a good testimony. 3 By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible." Heb. 11:1-3

II. F_____ Faith (4-7)

"By faith **Abel** offered to God a more excellent sacrifice...." (4) "By faith **Enoch** was taken away so that he did not see death,..." (5) "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diliaently seek Him." (6)

"By faith **Noah**...prepared an ark for the saving of his household...." (7)

III. F Faith (8-12)

"By faith Abraham obeyed...And he went out, not knowing where he was going." (8)

"By faith **Sarah...**bore a child when she was past the age..." (11)

IV. F_____ Faith (13-16)

"These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them. embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth." Heb. 11:13

V. F Faith (17-22)

"By faith **Abraham**, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, ..." (17) "By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come." (20)

"By faith Jacob, when he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, and worshiped,..." (21)

"By faith **Joseph**, when he was dying, made mention of the departure of the children of Israel,..." (22)

VI. F_____ Faith (23-31) "By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents,..." (23)

"By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter...." (24)

"By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible..." (27)
