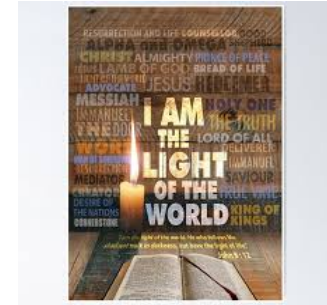

## **The Word Became Flesh - Introduction to John**

Author: John (13:23-25, 18:15-16, 19:26-27, 20:1-10, 21:7, 20-24) -  
"whom Jesus loved" & "the other disciple"

As an apostle of Jesus & a theologian, he focused his message on the doctrines & deity of Christ (as the Mighty God 1:1) & wrote his book to the whole world (3:16).

Date: Between 65-95 AD

Why? But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name - 20:31

The greatest/simplest salvation verse of all time - John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that  
whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Other salvation verses - 3:36, 4:13-14, 5:24, 6:27, 47, 68-69, 10:27-30  
(eternal security), 12:25, 17:3, 20:31

Last Verse And there are also many other things that Jesus did, which if they  
were written one by one, I suppose that even the world itself could  
not contain the books that would be written. Amen.
